Aetna Better Health of New Jersey is an existing client with CVS Caremark®. Effective September 1, 2024, per State of New Jersey Guidance and signed legislation (P.L. 2023, c.2.), Aetna Better Health New Jersey will reimburse pharmacies, that are registered with the state for providing education and consultation for related self-administered hormonal contraceptives dispensed pursuant to a statewide standing order, an additional administration fee of \$20.60.

To report that the member education and consultation session has been provided, the registered pharmacy must submit the following fields to receive reimbursement for the administration fee on its claim for the self-administered hormonal contraceptive. This reimbursement, and the billing instructions below, is only applicable to self-administered hormonal contraceptives dispensed pursuant the standing order; not to prescriptions received from Prescribers.

Reimbursement of the additional administration fee for the initial and follow-up consultation and education sessions is limited to two (2) claims per twelve (12) months per member/per registered pharmacy if there is no change in drug therapy.
