

CHIP Cost Sharing and Copayments for COVID-19 Vaccines, Treatment, and Testing Services

Clarification regarding CHIP copayments for COVID-19 Vaccines, Treatment, and Testing Services

CHIP members don't have to pay for COVID-19 vaccines, treatment, or tests. This includes drugs and test kits. You don't have to pay a co-payment for them. A provider or pharmacy can't ask you for one.

If you have a condition that affects COVID-19 then you don't have to pay for treatment of it while you have COVID-19. Some diseases, diabetes, cancer, and Down Syndrome complicate COVID-19. So do transplants, some therapies, and obesity.

You don't have to pay for COVID-19 preventive treatment. You don't have to pay to treat conditions caused by COVID.

There are no co-payments for these services for at least 12 months after the COVID-19 public health emergency period ends.
