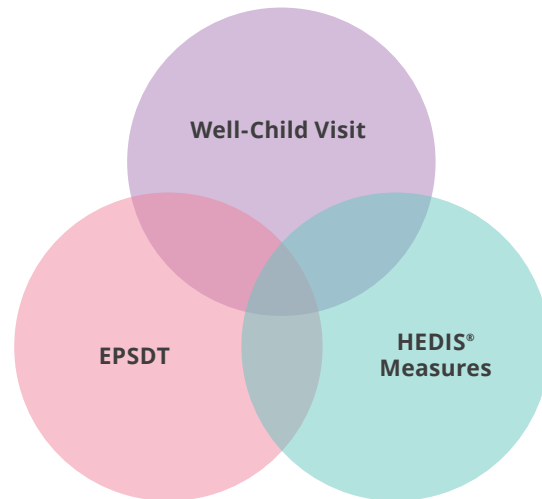


Pediatric Coding Guide



Capturing care for children from birth through 21 years of age

There is a significant overlap between HEDIS measures, EPSDT (Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment), and Bright Futures. EPSDT is Medicaid-specific and is based off of the Bright Futures guidelines, and the CHIP Program follows Bright Futures. The codes offered in this guide cover key HEDIS measures that will also satisfy care required under EPSDT and Bright Futures guidelines:

- Flouride varnish treatments (EPSDT and Bright Futures preventive measure)
- Childhood Immunization Status (CIS)
- Chlamydia Screening in Women (16 years and older) (CHL)
- Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life (DVS)
- Follow-Up Care for Children Prescribed ADHD Medication (ADD)
- Immunizations for Adolescents (IMA)
- Lead Screening in Children (LSC)
- Weight assessment and counseling for children and adolescents (WCC)
- Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30)
- *Child and Adolescent Well Care Visits (WCV)*

Telehealth Revisions Measurement years 2020 and 2021

The NCQA wants to support the increased use of telehealth patient care caused by the pandemic. These updated guidelines were released on July 1st, 2020. To capture telehealth care, submit all claims using the applicable CPT code with the GT Modifier (UB-04 & CMS 1500). The following measures now accept telehealth:

- ADD
- WCC
 - Nutrition and Physical Activity Counseling
 - BMI%ile: Member-reported height, weight, BMI percentile are acceptable only if the information is collected by a primary care practitioner or specialist, if the specialist is providing a primary care service related to the condition being assessed, while taking a patient's history. The information must be recorded, dated and maintained in the member's legal health record.

Fluoride Varnish

Fluoride varnish is a dental treatment that can help strengthen enamel, prevent tooth decay, slow it down, or stop it from getting worse. This preventive service satisfies EPSDT and Bright Futures dental requirements for members age 0-5 years. This service can be performed by a PCP during a routine outpatient visit up to four times a year.

In order to satisfy EPSDT/Bright Futures requirements for this service both of the following codes should be submitted on the same claim/DOS:

The CIS measure captures the percentage of children who turned 2 years of age during the measurement year and had vaccinations, with different dates of service, on or by their second birthday:

The CHL measure captures the percentage of women 16–24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year.

IMA

The IMA measure captures the percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who had one dose of meningococcal vaccine, one tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine, and have completed the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series by their 13th birthday.

*Please note- for the HPV vaccine it is recommended that adolescents have 3 vaccinations between the 9th and 13th birthdays OR Two vaccinations as long as there is at least 146 days between the first and second dose of the HPV vaccine.

DVS

The DVS measure captures the percentage of children turning 1 – 3 years of age during the measurement year that are screened for risk of developmental, behavioral, and social delays using a standardized screening tool in the 12 months preceding or on their first, second or third birthday.

ADD

The ADD measure captures the percentage of children newly prescribed attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder ADHD medication who had at least three follow-up care visits within a 10-month period, one of which was within 30 days of when the first ADHD medication was dispensed.

LSC

The LSC measure captures the percentage of children 2 years of age who had one or more capillary or venous lead blood test for lead poisoning by their second birthday.

*Per EPSDT requirements two blood level screenings should have occurred by age 2.

WCC

The WCC measure captures the percentage of members 3–17 years of age who had an outpatient visit with a PCP or OB/GYN and who had evidence of the following during the measurement year:

- BMI Percentile (not value)
- Counseling for nutrition
- Counseling for physical activity

W30

The W30 measure looks for members who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during the last 15 months. The following rates are reported:

- *Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months.* Children who turned 15 months old during the measurement year: Six or more well-child visits.
- *Well-Child Visits for Age 15 Months–30 Months.* Children who turned 30 months old during the measurement year: Two or more well-child visits.

Use one of these approved codes to administratively capture all of the components of a well care exam:

The WCV measure looks at members 3–21 years of age who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a PCP or an OB/GYN practitioner during the measurement year.
